

KOŚCIELISKA VALLEY

The Kościeliska Valley, the second largest (about 9 km in length, 34 km² area) and the most beautiful valley on the Polish side of the Tatra Mountains, is located some 5 km from Zakopane. From around 450 caves discovered till now in the area, four of them are available for tourists: Mroźna (temperature 6°C all over the year, 570 m long trail, the only one from the four caves with electric light), Raptawicka, Mylna and Smocza Jama – all definitely cold, even in a hot summer.



A wide walking path, which leads through the rocky valley, gets narrow in some places creating the so-called gates, including Kankak Gate and Kraszewski Gate. After one-hour walk from the entrance of the valley the Kraków Gorge can be reached - a narrow path between monumental rocks. In the upper part of the valley tourists find a shelter built in 1940s on the Ornak Pasture, offering outstanding views on the surrounding mountain scenery.
