

CHOCHOŁOWSKA VALLEY

The Chochołowska Valley is a beautiful place located to the south-west of Zakopane. It is the longest (about 10 km in length) and the largest (35,6 km²) valley within the area of the Tatra National Park. The valley was a favorite place of Pope John Pole II for walks and contemplating the beauty of the Polish Tatra Mountains.



In the lower part of the valley there are many caves made in rocks by water. The Chochołowska Valley is divided into three smaller valleys in its higher end. Astonishing meadows strawn with flowers and the almost flat terrain offer perfect walking conditions for visitors of any age and preparation. In the end of the valley tourists can reach a picturesque mountain shelter with something tasty to eat and drink.
