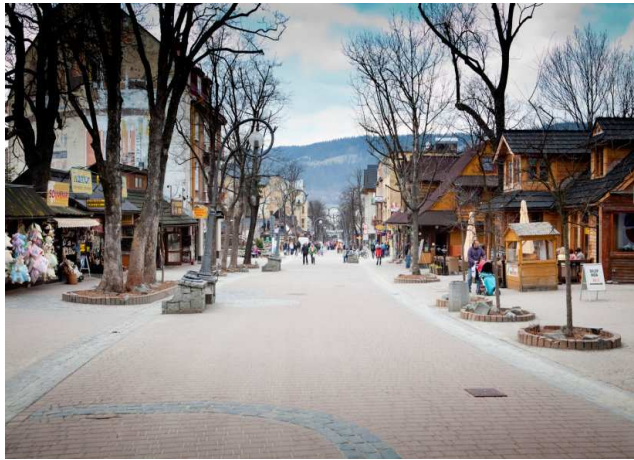


ZAKOPANE AND CHOCHOŁÓW

The city of Zakopane is informally regarded as the winter capital of Poland. Nevertheless it is very popular all over the year due to the outstanding beauty of Polish highlanders' culture, unique architecture and folklore. The International Festival of Highland Folklore organized in Zakopane for more than 40 years is now the oldest and the largest folklore event in Europe.



About 17 km east from Zakopane visitors can enjoy the peaceful atmosphere of the XIXth century village of Chochołów, which is the most complete presentation of the traditional style highland architecture. The village is recognized by UNESCO on the world heritage list for its special cultural significance. Preserved old wooden houses and folkloric decorative art can make visitors feel moved back in time, into the history of the beautiful region of Podhale.



The programme includes:

- Service of a licensed guide during the tour
- Tour of Zakopane and the surrounding area, including the oldest part of Zakopane with its beautiful wooden architecture, the famous Jaszczurówka chapel, the ski jumps and the sports area, Cyrhla – the highest part of Zakopane, the Fatima Sanctuary, a visit to a smoke-house for tasting the cheese made of sheep milk and a trip to the top of Gubalówka Hill for more views on both Zakopane city and the Tatra Mountains.
- Visit to the village of Chochołów– a picturesque village with the best-preserved and largest complex of traditional wooden houses in the area.
